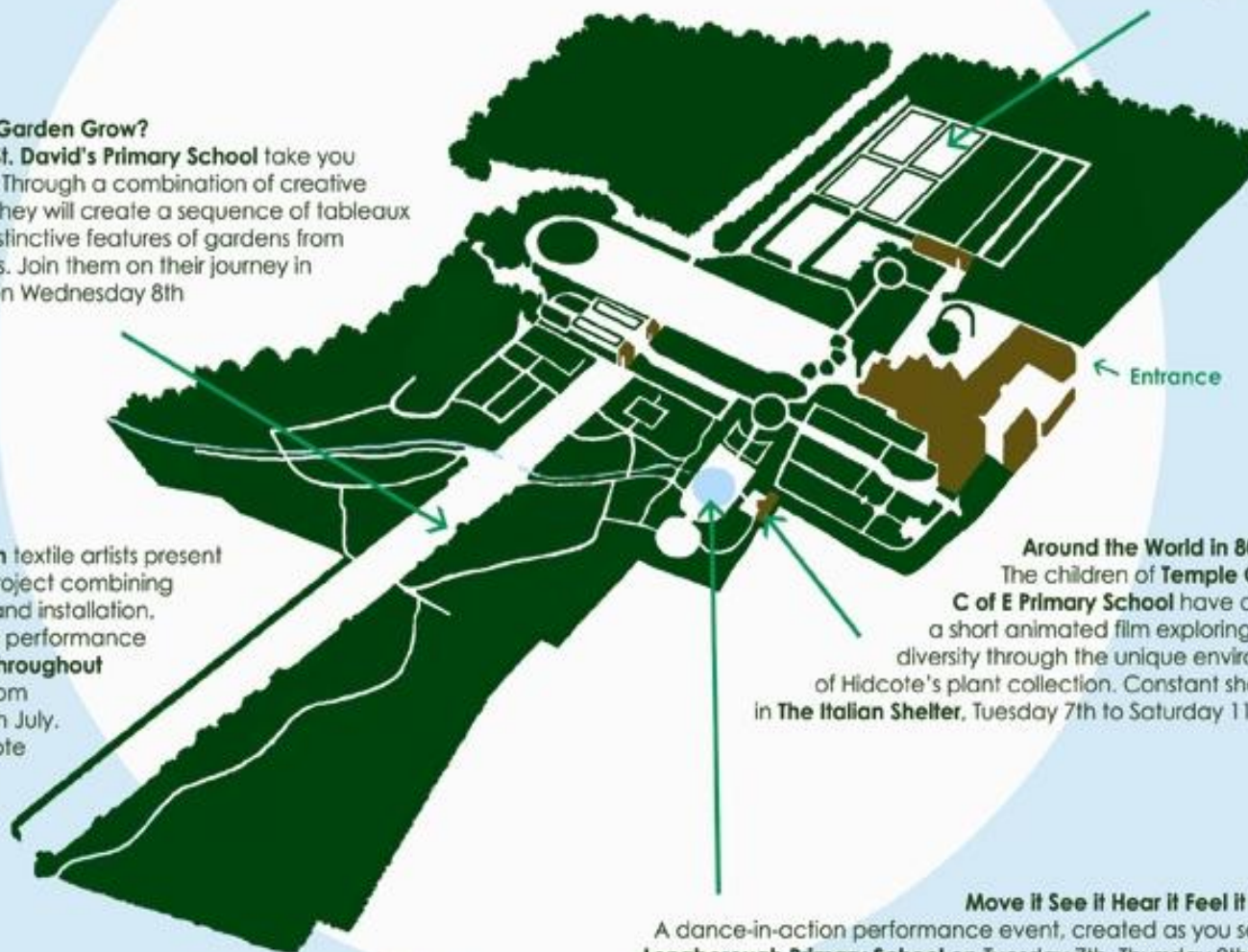
CUT 2 ON FOLD
